### State Bank of Travancore joins NSDL as DP

State Bank of Travancore has been made operational as a DP on June 12, 2006. It will conduct its depository operations from Thiruvananthapuram. The DP Id allotted is IN303124.

### Computer Age Management Services Private Limited joins NSDL as DP

Computer Age Management Services Private Limited has been made operational as a DP on June 23, 2006. It will conduct its depository operations from Chennai. The DP Id allotted is IN303149.

### Union Bank of India joins NSDL as DP

Union Bank of India has been made operational as a DP on June 27, 2006. It will conduct its depository operations from Mumbai. The DP Id allotted is IN303157.

### Intimation of list of holidays for the calendar year to clients by DPs

NSDL has been receiving complaints from the demat account holders (Clients) that the DPs do not give adequate notice to the Clients about non-availability of depository services due to holidays. In order to avoid hardship to the Clients, NSDL has advised DPs to send a communication to all the Clients about the list of holidays for the calendar year and display the list of holidays in a prominent place, at each of the office from where the depository services are being provided.

This has been intimated to DPs vide Circular No. NSDL/POLICY/2006/0017 dated June 5, 2006.

## Performance Summary

As on June 30, 2006, there are 77,42,921 Investor accounts from within the country and abroad. 2,095 clearing member accounts have been opened to facilitate trading and settlement of demat shares in the stock exchanges connected to NSDL. Table 1 shows the growth in investor accounts over a period of three years.

### Dematerialisation :

As on June 30, 2006, 18,686 cr. securities having a value of Rs. 23,66,090 cr. were dematerialised. Table 2 shows the dematerialisation figures over the last three years.

## Topic of Interest

### FAQs on Power of Attorney

#### 1. What is Power of Attorney (POA)?

*Ans.* Section 1-A of The Powers of Attorney Act, 1882 defines Power of Attorney as “Power of Attorney includes any instrument empowering a specified person to act for and in the name of the person executing it”.

**Meaning of POA:** A power of attorney is an authority given by way of a formal instrument whereby one person, who is called the donor or principal, authorises another person, who is called the donee, attorney or agent, to act on his behalf.

#### 2. After executing a POA, who could operate a demat account?

*Ans.* (i) The accountholder(s);  
(ii) The person who has been authorised to operate the demat account.

**3. After executing POA, if the accountholder(s) give(s) any instruction, does it imply that the POA is revoked?**

*Ans.* No.

**4. Can the accountholder supercede the instruction given by the POA holder?**

*Ans.* Yes. However, the POA holder cannot supercede the instructions given by the accountholder.

**5. Can my DP insist on executing a POA at the time of opening demat account?**

*Ans.* Giving POA is a right of an accountholder, not an obligation. Your DP cannot insist on executing a POA in its favour or in favour of any third person.

**6. Is there a standard POA format?**

*Ans.* No. POA format depends upon the rights and obligations agreed between the donor and donee.

**7. What precautions should I take before executing a POA?**

*Ans.* The following precautions should be taken before executing a POA:

- (i) Before executing a POA, read the contents/ clauses mentioned in the POA carefully. It is necessary to understand the implications of every clause before signing the POA.
- (ii) Only if it is essential, give a POA. But execute the POA in favour of a person in whom you have full faith and trust.
- (iii) Do not authorise the POA to change your address and bank details.
- (iv) Even after giving POA, monitor the activities in your account. Check the transactions in your demat account that are appearing in the Transaction Statement provided by your DP. If you have Internet access, you may subscribe to NSDL's internet based facility viz., **IDeAS** that would give you an ability to view the balances and transactions in your demat account.
- (v) The actions of a valid POA are as good as you having performed the act yourselves. You will not be able to deny the transaction at a later date.

**8. Is there any alternate available for operating my demat account, if I do not want to give POA or submit delivery instruction slips ?**

*Ans.* You can use NSDL's internet based facility - **SPEED-e** that enables demat accountholder(s) (including Clearing Members) to submit delivery instructions directly on the internet.
